From **June 13th to 15th 2015**, the ACLIMAS project (CIHEAM - Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Bari in collaboration with the **Egyptian Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation, MWRI**) organized a Training workshop on "**Climate Change Adaptation for Water, Food and Environment Security**". The Training course was held at Regional Training Sector for Water Resources and Irrigation

6th of October City, Cairo- Egypt.

The 3-days training brought together 60 experts: 18 lecturers and 42 trainees (Policy makers, Officials, Researchers, Practitioners and students) in irrigated agriculture, water, agri-food production and environmental issues. The participants (**40% gender equity**) were affiliated to different Research Centers, Academia and Universities and Agricultural departments across Egypt working together in interdisciplinary teams. Three participants came from the **MARSADEV** project focussed on the adoption of the Integrated Water Resources Management approach in the region of Marsa Matrouh in Egypt. **Ciheam-IAM of Bari** was represented by Prof. **A. Hamdy**, Prof. **M. Todorovic**, Dr. **A. Daccache** and Dr. **N. Driouech**. In addition, **6 Egyptian** participants/Trainees were from **Ciheam Alumni, MAIB Former Trainees Network (FTN)**.

The training began with the opening ceremony in which participated Prof. **Essam Khalifa**, the Head of the Minister office (MWRI) and the SWIM National Focal Point, Eng. **Nagwa Ahmed**, the Head of the Regional Training Centre (RTWRI) and the CIHEAM-Bari-Aclimas representatives. The three days of presentations and interaction sessions were held with the participation- the leading national scientist

on different aspects of climate change impact and the mitigation and adaptation options at the national scale- mainly on the Nile delta region. The

training themes ranged from Water-Energy-Food Nexus and Socio-economic impact assessment of Climate Change to the technical water management sessions and policy analysis.
